





OUESTION:

What do the seven colors of the rainbow mean?

ANSWER:

"Noah's rainbow composed primarily of seven color. Anybody knows the rainbow's got seven color. Now, what are the color? Red, orange, violet... No, red--red, orange, green, blue, indigo, and violet. That's the color of the rainbow. Now, we got a deep thing here, and I'm just going to have to hit the high spots of it, 'cause it's getting too late. Now, remember, orange...or, red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, and violet. Now, if you notice, seven... Watch. Seven rainbows... Seven color; I mean, seven-colored rainbow. That meant seven bows. Seven bows, seven churches reflecting seven lights, each light wrapped into the other one. It started off with red, red. After red come orange, which is a reflection of red. After orange was... After--after orange come vellow, which is red and orange mixed together, makes vellow. Then green, green and blue makes black. Then come indigo. And then from indigo comes violet, which is part of blue. Oh, oh, oh. Hallelujah. Don't you see? God, in His seven-colored rainbow, His covenant that He made, a covenant that through Seven Church Ages, the seven color He would save the earth." mercy among us, by gifts and signs and wonders. That whole big rainbow had become in a theophany, of made in the image like man. Yet, He wasn't a man; He didn't have flesh, yet. He was a theophany." [Hebrews Chapter Six, Part Three 57-0915M, Jeffersonville, Indiana]

"Red to us speaks of danger. Red is not a good color to us, in the way of speaking worldly. "Red" sometimes means "the--the danger sign." But red, also in the Scriptures speak of redemption. Red has been God's sign of redemption, punishment. Did you notice all the way down through the Scripture from the days of Adam, all the way down through until this day it's been one scarlet streak of red, blood. I often wonder how people can shun the Blood of the Lord Jesus the way they do after they see in His suffering." [The Waters Of Separation 55-0606, Macon, Georgia]

"In there, we find out that, He had seven varieties of Spirit. Is that right? The Bible said, in the Revelation, that, "The seven Spirits before the Throne of God." Is that right? And seven Spirits, and those Spirits were perfect. The first was the color of red; perfect love, redemption. And how, if we had time, to give those color and show that each one of those color represents God's purity. Amen. Those color, there is seven natural color. Those **color** represents the purity of God. And the... Those color represents the motives of God, the attitude of God. Those seven color, they represented seven church ages, seven stars, seven angels. All through the Scripture, seven ministers, seven messengers, seven messages, all in the sevens. Seven days. Six days, and the seventh is the sabbath; perfect, complete. Oh, it's beautiful, if we just had the time to dig into it and to bring it out, those color!" "Take the color red. We take the first color, is red. What is red? Red is one sign of danger. Red is a sign of redemption. And you look at red through red, what color is it? White. That's correct. So when the red Blood was shed, to cover red sin; God, looking through red Blood, look at red sin, it becomes white. The believer can't sin. Certainly not. The Seed of God, the blessings of God, remains on him. God can't see nothing but the Blood of His own Son. No matter what it is in His Church, what it is, God don't see it, because Jesus is making intercessions, constantly, the High Priest. No way for him to sin, when such a Sacrifice is laying there for him, like that. Certainly not. And now if you say, "Well, that gives me a good chance..." Then that shows you're not right. / Hebrews Chapter Seven, Part Two 57-0922, Jeffersonville, Indiana

"There's three stages of everything. There's a stage of the mortal body, the immortal body, and then the glorified body. See? Just like, other things, like Father, Son, and Holy Spirit goes in one channel, and the three makes the one. Justification, sanctification, baptism of the Holy Ghost in a channel makes the one. And--and soul. body, and spirit makes the one. And it travels in three's, and three's are one. And take a--a three cornered piece of glass and lay it in the sun, it'll reflect the color. Isn't that strange that red through red looks white? **Red** is the sign of redemption. And when you... God looks at our RED sins through the **RED** blood of His precious Son; they're white. See? Excerpts From Guestbook, Testimonybook, & Eye Witness Accounts

June 22, 2012 - 02:52 AM Chiedza from Zimbabwe My 15 year son was sick period 16 April to 3 May 2012. He was wrongly diagnosed twice. First the doctor said he had a stomach infection and was given medication but the situation did not improve, 4 days later another doctor suspected that he had critical hepatitis. by then his organs were failing, his urine had turned coke back, they said his liver was swollen, he had high temperature and was dehydrated. he was put on drip while they send his blood for tests. that night 16 April 2012 he was admitted into hospital and we were told that he was dying unless there was a miracle. We began praying for him and called our pastor for prayers. That night I did not sleep, I was crying to God in prayer, and read many verses for healing. The next day, I was not sure if my son had made it through the night, I was so restless and scared. I finally called the hospital and asked the nurse how my son was doing, she said not too good. That alone was a miracle for me, the fact that he was still breathing meant there was still hope, the results showed that he had severe cerebral malaria and severe typhoid combination, we had many questions why?, how?, we saw the hand of the Lord in the care he received from the doctors they were kind and committed. he was put in intensive care unit on life support, because he was no longer able to breath on his own, the doctors put him under aesthetician and put him to sleep because his organs needed to rest while they administered medication. He partially woke up 4 days later but still on n life support machine, for days we visited him, talked to him prayed, it was hard and painful. Sometimes I asked God why, sometimes I tried to sing, sometimes I just cried. As the days passed we were told his blood pressure was too low, his left lung was collapsing, he had pneumonia in the chest, his blood was not clotting, his blood was not enough, he needed new human blood plasma, his temperature would go too high, too low, and other medical terms which were all so complicated. It was during one of those trying days I met a young nurse who attends Living Word Ministries in Belvedere Harare, Zimbabwe, She gave me a number to call Pastor Chidoti. I called the pastor and explained my son's situation and he said lets pray over the phone. He prayed for my son for almost 30 minutes. From that day each time I went for the visit my son's results were improving for the better. Slowly they began to remove him from the live support machinery. It was a miracle he was discharged on 3 May. On the day he was discharged the medical staff thanked God, most of them told us they never thought he would make it. He is now back at school. I thank God for healing my son. Thank you Pastor Chidoti for your prayer. May the Lord continue to bless you as you go on working for Him.
